Denise called the meeting to order at 6:07. Officer Hamilton was invited to speak. He stated that the state police are making an effort to talk to each town in NH about active shooter situations and plans to handle one. He is also discussing the topic with the Blue School. His request was to add culverts and gates to Finkle Field so it can be used for parking/staging emergency vehicles if an active shooter situation should occur. The idea was discussed, and it was agreed that two entrances would be ideal. Officer Hamilton left the meeting at 6:14 PM

Denise reported that she attempted to call The Conway Area Humane Society, but their number was not in service. She did send an email but has not received a reply.

Harry asked about the location of the key to the mailbox as requested by Cathy Ferony. The Board will have to check with Fran for future reference. Minutes were reviewed and signed. Jenn Locke joined the meeting at 6:41 PM. In addition, treasurer reports for May and June were reviewed and signed.

There was a building permit for review. The Board will hold off on forwarding it to the Highway Dept until a new Zoning Officer can be appointed. Denise will send a letter to the Planning Board to ask if they have a recommendation or a member interested in the position. The Board will advertise in the Ledger after a reply from the Planning Board.

The Board took a moment to recognize the passing of Tom Blowey and to honor all of his service to the Town. All agreed he will be missed. A card was written and signed for the family to share our condolences.

Checks were reviewed and signed.

There was discussion of the Woolly Rd properties and the subject of whether it is a town road. The board reviewed tax files and determined that more investigation would need to be done with deeds from the registry. The board also reviewed tax files for the Gustafson/Fitzgerald property sales and determined more research was needed, as well. The board will discuss again next week with Fran present and eventually have the assessor look in to the situation.

At 7:49 PM Denise made a motion to adjourn, Jenn seconded it. The meeting adjourned.
