

Vital Records/Genealogy

Marriage Licenses and Certificates

The Town Clerk may issue a marriage license to the applicants the same day of the application, provided all signatures and statutory requirements are met:

- Proof of age
- Photo ID
- A certified copy of a death certificate of a former spouse if applicant is widowed
- A certified copy of a final divorce decree of the applicant is divorced
- A certified copy of an annulment decree if the applicant's previous marriage was annulled
- Birth certificates of the applicants
- Both parties must appear in person to file marriage intentions as the signature of each is required.
- The license shall be valid for not more than 90 days from the date of filing.
- The marriage license fee is \$50

Certified Copies of Birth and Death Certificates and Marriage Licenses

Certified copies of birth, marriage and death records may be obtained at the Town Office. The fee is \$15. Additional copies purchased at the same time are \$10.

Note: Any person shall be guilty of a Class B felony if he/she willfully and knowingly makes any false statement in an application for a certified copy of a vital record per [RSA 126:24-I](#).

Genealogy Research

During office hours you may search the public portion of Town Record books on marriages, births, deaths
